

Approved Devices

Year 11 and 12 students are able to use the following approved type of device, when accessing the CRC Sydenham private network:

1. Windows laptop

Minimum specs

- 802.11ac WiFi (WiFi 5)
- i3/i5/i7 or AMD Dual Core Processor/CPU
- 4GB RAM
- 128GB HDD/SSD

Recommended specs

- 802.11ax WiFi (WiFi 6)
- 8GB RAM
- 256GB SSD
- i5/i7 10th Generation and above or similar AMD
- 6 hour battery life

2. Macbook (minimum specs)

Minimum specs

- Macbook, Macbook Pro, Macbook Air – 2015 or later

Recommended specs

- Macbook Pro, Macbook Air M1, M2 or Better

Approved operating systems

- Windows 10 version 22H2
- macOS version 12 or newer

Please note: All devices must have WIFI 5/6 capabilities

If all requirements are met, students will be able to connect their devices to a wireless network named **CRCS** using their network username and password. This network applies the same content filtering rules as the existing Student network.

As BYO Devices are not College owned there is limited support available from the ICT Services for various reasons.

If the device has not been supplied by CRC Sydenham the following applies:

- The device has to meet a minimum requirement or specification.
- ICT will endeavor to assist the student gaining access to the wireless network and services. ICT may be able to diagnose but not fix hardware issues.
- ICT will not be responsible for patching or upgrading operating systems. Some applications used in the classroom may require a minimum version of an operating system to load and or function. This applies to all vendors or devices.
- Any device not supplied by the College is the responsibility of the owner, this covers all hardware and software issues.
- The College is not responsible for the damage, loss or theft of any BYO Device.
- The College will not recommend vendors for any repairs required to BYO Devices.
